SLOW STITCHING Explore contemporary textile collage using a wide range of fabrics, threads, stitches and techniques.

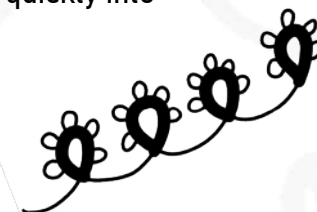


TAPESTRY Using interlaced threads to create beautiful pictures.
